

CONSTITUTION
of
Adams County 4-H Leaders' Council
The Governing body of all East Adams County 4H Clubs

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the organization shall be the Adams County 4-H Leaders Council.

ARTICLE II - PURPOSE

The purpose of the organization shall be to advance the best interest of 4-H Club work in Adams County and to cooperate with the county and state extension offices.

ARTICLE III - MEMBERSHIP

Section 1 - Voting membership for council shall be all 4-H club leaders.

Section 2 - Ex-Officio membership –Members of Washington State University Extension, Adams County Extension and representatives of sponsoring organizations may hold ex-officio membership, be entitled to the privileges of the floor, but shall have no vote.

ARTICLE IV -OFFICERS AND DUTIES

Section 1 - The officers of the organization shall consist of a president, a vice-president, and a secretary-treasurer. These officers shall be the Executive Committee. The officers shall be elected and installed on or before November 1. The appointive officers shall be a parliamentarian and a recreation leader. The appointive officers shall be appointed by the president without confirmation of the executive committee.

Section 2 - Duties of the Council Officers –All officers shall perform their duties in accordance with Roberts Rules of Order with the following exception: the president shall, in appointing standing committees, or filling vacancies in elective offices secure the approval of the executive committee. The secretary-treasurer shall (a) submit to the Extension office a copy in writing of the minutes of each meeting within one week and (b) shall have the Treasurer Fund audited by an auditing committee before turning Fund over to new officers.

ARTICLE V – NUMBER OF MEETINGS

Section 1 - Leaders Council - The council shall establish regular meetings and special meetings whenever the president deems necessary.

ARTICLE VI -AMENDING THIS CONSTITUTION

Section I - The constitution may be amended at any regular meeting provided that the amendments are submitted in writing to members of the council one week before the meeting of the council. The council must approve the amendment by a 2/3 vote of members present.

AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF THE ADAMS COUNTY 4-H LEADERS COUNCIL

DISSOLUTION CLAUSE

In the event of the dissolution of the Adams County 4-H Leaders Council, any funds in the treasury shall become the property of the Statewide 4-H Leaders Council.
